Objectives

The Conference is held every three years and organized for the field of accessible transportation, researchers, policy-makers, transport operators and consumers. This conference presents scientific and conceptual advances in the pursuit of mobility and access for people with disabilities and older adults. The theme of the conference is “Mobility for all: Connecting the World with Accessible Transportation.” The conference starts off with a plenary lecture, and continues with different types of meeting, in which researchers, practitioners, service providers, policy planners, educators, and workers with various tasks in the ageing related field around the world are invited to discuss the latest new development and research findings in accessible transportation.

It is expected the Conference would enable the rehabilitation workers to better understand the global perspective in the current situation and explore strategies for a new perspective to develop an inclusive and accessible transport in Hong Kong. In addition, delegates are expected to build up networking with overseas organizations and disabled groups. Delegates will be able to understand the worldwide development of this issue and to create exchange and mutual benefits.
