Objectives

The 2019-20 Policy Address of HKSAR has announced that the Integrated Community Centre for Mental Wellness (ICCMW) will expand the services to Secondary School students who may suffer from mental health problems. In addition, innovative measures are required to meet the multiple needs of the people in recovery as the ICCMW is an integrative service serving people with wide range of ages (from Secondary school students to elderly people), different types and stages of mental illnesses. As the United Kingdom has a lot of pioneer mental health services that we could take reference to, it is expected that this UK trip would let the Hong Kong delegates to expose to and learn from the worldwide experiences of people, especially the UK experiences. The learning will facilitate the development of mental health service models particularly in local context. The events will also serve as a platform to expand the network of both local and overseas mental health professionals.
