The Ministerial Declaration proclaimed in 2012 for the Asia and Pacific Decade of Disabled Persons, 2013 to 2022, adopted the ***Incheon Strategy to Make the Rights Real***. Two years into the Third A/P Decade, APDF, in cooperation with international organizations and other member organizations, will organize the first APDF conference to review recent developments and deliberating on new strategies.

1. Poverty reduction and access to human rights of persons with disabilities
2. UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities, Millennium Development Goals (MDGs), Incheon Strategy and post-2015 development strategies
3. Participation and access of young people with disabilities in the Third Asian and Pacific Decade of Disabled Persons, 2013-2022
